

APPLIED HOLISTIC NUTRITION DIPLOMA IHN-OL SELF-PACED PROGRAM

The *Applied Holistic Nutrition Diploma Self Paced* program provides a Diploma upon graduation and a Certified Nutritional Practitioner (CNP) certification. There are 397 Lecture hours and a mandatory <u>minimum</u> 100-hour co-op placement totaling 497 program hours, with an additional projected 1732 hours of independent study including case studies, course work, readings and examinations. The program is lasting approximately one year and available up to 3 years to complete from program commencement date. *Language of Instruction is English – Strictly on-line delivery.*

Program Details

Entry is usually as per structured semesters January, May, and September starts. Registration is open year-round. Students on average complete the program in one year (*full-time study*) and all students have up to 3 years to complete the Diploma in Applied Holistic Nutrition program. Within this time frame, students must adhere to their registration schedule. All course content is delivered online. Digital course notes are provided at the start of each course, ensuring the most up-to-date material is available. All books on the required textbook list are available to purchase from IHN-On-Line.

Admission Requirements

To be eligible for entry, applicants must provide prior to commencement of program:

□ Accredited High School Diploma **OR** Mature Student Status (minimum 21 years of age) **OR** Canadian Adult Achievement Test-Level D (CAAT-Level D) **OR** Certificate of Graduation or equivalent **OR** Post-secondary documentation

- □ Completed IHN-On-Line Enrolment Contract
- □ An autobiography (2-3 pages typed and doubled-spaced about yourself and your interest in this field)
- □ A Program Advising Session
- □ English Language Proficiency, when necessary
- □ Non-refundable enrollment fee
- □ Government Issued Photo Identification

*All documentation is to be emailed to <u>registration@ihn-on-line.com</u>. Please note that registration cannot be processed without: a completed enrollment contract, a program advising session, all required documentation, and a non-refundable enrollment fee of CDN \$250, regardless of the chosen payment option.

Payment Fees - Schedule Options (Current fees are applicable to students commencing the program in 2024)

Upon registration, IHN-On-Line requires a CDN \$250 non-refundable tuition deposit/enrollment fee. Acceptable methods of payment are E-Transfer, Cheque, MasterCard, Visa and Money Order. All tuition invoices/receipts are e-mailed, unless requested otherwise. No refunds are issued upon payment plan option changes.

Option A Enrollment fee (non refundable) due with registration: CDN \$250.00 4 installments (3-month intervals recommended): CDN \$1,650.00. First installment is due prior to the commencement of Semester. Semester start dates: Jan, May, Sept.

Option B Enrollment fee (*non refundable*) due with registration: CDN \$250.00. Payment of tuition on a course-bycourse basis is due on or prior to the first day of class. Please view IHN-On-Line's website or ask a Program Advisor for details. The course fees are subject to change at any time, with the student paying the most current fee for a course.

Course Exemptions

Official transcripts must be submitted before the commencement of the program in order for a tuition reduction to be processed for exemptions granted. Official transcripts submitted or request for exemption after the student commencement of the program will receive consideration for course exemption but will receive NO tuition credit.

Canadian Residents - T2202 Tax Receipts

Social Insurance Numbers (SIN) must be provided as per Canada Revenue Agency for the issuance of tax receipts where applicable. Tax receipts, where applicable, within Canada Revenue Agency guidelines will be issued, for the tuition portion fees paid during the applicable tax year. Additional Considerations

- Upon program commencement, the enrollment fee, administrative fees, and tuition paid to date is valid up to 3 years.

- An individual has up to 3 years to complete the program from the initial start date. This enrollment contract and program becomes null and void after the 3-year period from initial start date.

- Refund Policy Conditions: Tuition paid will be eligible for refund until access is provided for commencement of the program less enrollment and admin fees. Once access is provided to student, no refund is eligible.

• Official Exemptions

Applicants with credits from an accredited post-secondary educational institute may be exempt from certain health science courses only, provided that these credits meet IHN-On-Line's standards. Exemptions <u>may</u> be provided at the IHN-ON-LINE's discretion:

- Human Anatomy and Physiology (HAP01)
- Organic Chemistry (BC001)
- Biochemistry (BM002)

Students who seek advanced standing must apply to an IHN Program Advisor with official transcripts from a recognized. post-secondary school a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the program or individual course to receive exemption consideration. To receive a course exemption, two full semesters must be completed within the relevant program of study within the past ten years. An average of 70% or above in the related course is required. If advanced standing is granted prior to registration, a tuition deduction of the course exemption amount will be applied. Official transcripts submitted after the commencement of the program will receive consideration for course exemption but will receive no tuition credit.

- Graduation Eligibility Policy To qualify for the annual Spring graduation; please refer to the following assigned deadline of Feb 15 to complete the following: required course work completion, field trips (herb walk and farm trip) and the mandatory Agreement/Evaluation Form completion minimum required 100 Co-op hours submitted to IHN-OL.
- Attendance policy: Attendance in the Self-Paced program is considered the observance of the video lectures. All lecture videos
 must be watched to ensure proper instruction is provided while maintaining academic integrity. Watching the lecture videos is
 mandatory and is an integral part of the learning process. Student's progress through the Self-Paced program is monitored and
 audited to ensure compliance. A student's inability to abide by this policy will result in a course failure.
- Tuition Fees Policy: Students are responsible for paying their tuition in order to gain access to the program and course materials. Updates to credit card information are the responsibility of the student. All tuition and fees are due in Canadian currency equivalency.
- Academic Dismissal Policy: (Any dismissal/expulsion from the program results in no refund to the student) A student will be dismissed from the program without warning for gross misconduct, as outlined in IHN-On-Line's Code of Conduct. Copyright, unauthorized distribution of program materials is grounds for immediate dismissal from the program without refund.
